

Terms and Conditions for Day Visitors at the 23rd World Scout Jamboree

As of 9 February 2015

Terms and Conditions for Day Visitors

In order to ensure that the Jamboree is held smoothly and safely, Day Visitors are requested to ensure that their behaviour is in accordance with the terms and conditions. By completing payment or receiving an official Day Visitor invitation, you indicate your acknowledgement and acceptance of these terms and conditions.

1. Host Organisation

The 23rd World Scout Jamboree is the Official International Event of the World Organization of the Scout Movement, and hosted by the Scout Association of Japan.

2. Day Visitor

Day Visitors may enter the Jamboree site during the designated opening hours on Thursday 30th July, Friday 31st July, Saturday 1st August, Monday 3rd August, Tuesday 4th August, Wednesday 5th August, and Thursday 6th August, 2015. Other than during the designated opening hours, Day Visitors are not permitted to be at the Jamboree site. In addition, Day Visitors are not allowed to stay over night.

3. Prior Registration

Day Visitors are required to register in advance and also at the site. If tickets are still available on the day, people who have not registered in advance may be able to purchase tickets for that day at the Jamboree site. However, depending on the circumstances, site registration may be closed at any time.

4. Refund of Fees

In the case of purchase by credit card, for a cancellation request made within 50 days of payment, a full refund will be provided. For a cancellation request made more than 50 days after payment, JPY 500 will be deducted from the refund. In the case of purchase at a convenience store or ATM machine, JPY 500 will be deducted from the refund on cancellation of any time. In addition, for a cancellation request made after the 1st of July, no refund will be provided. The Jamboree may be cancelled for compelling reasons such as an infectious disease or a natural disaster, or an act of terrorism. In such case, tickets will not be refunded.

5. Jamboree Programme

The host organization may change or cancel the Jamboree without prior notice. Day Visitors will not have access to the module programmes or to the events in the Jamboree.

6. Safety

(1) Clothing and Admission

- Day Visitors are required to wear ID, which will be distributed upon arrival, at all times in the Jamboree site.
- As the Jamboree site has little shade and Day Visitors will be walking around, they should bring hats, towels and drinks. They should be aware of high risk of heat strokes.
- As Day Visitors will be walking around the site, they should wear comfortable shoes.
- Day Visitors wearing inappropriate clothing may be refused admission.

- Children and youths should be accompanied by a sufficient number of adults capable of supervising the health and safety of the group.
- No animals, with the exception of guide dogs, will be permitted to enter the Jamboree site with Day Visitors.
- Day Visitors with tattoos should wear clothing that covers up the tattoos.

(2) Belongings

- Day Visitors should take their trash with them when they leave the site.
- Swapping badges between adults and youths under 18 years of age is prohibited at the Jamboree site.
- Alcoholic drinks shall not be brought into the site.
- The bringing of hazardous items, such as fireworks or knives, into the site is forbidden.

(3) Behaviour

The following behaviour is forbidden.

- Entering areas prohibited for Day Visitors.
- The consumption of alcoholic drinks at the Jamboree site or when entering the site.
- Smoking in non-smoking areas.
- Bringing hazardous materials, such as fireworks or knives, into the Jamboree site.
- Bringing inappropriately large items into the Jamboree site.
- Selling or displaying commercial products.
- Distributing flyers, holding rallies or making speeches.
- Photography or filming for commercial purposes.
- Antisocial behaviour, causing a nuisance to other Day Visitors or participants.
- Any disruption to the management of the Jamboree.
- Behaviour inimical to the smooth and safe holding of the Jamboree.

(4) Security

The host organization may check the belongings of Day Visitors or require them to present identification. Any Day Visitor who annoys other Day Visitors or participants, brings hazardous items into the site or refuses to obey the instructions of officials may be asked to leave the site. In such case, neither the cost of admission nor parking fees will be refunded.

7. Handling Personally Identifiable Information, Images and Video

Personal information gathered in the course of Jamboree Registration will be used for compiling a list of participants to facilitate management of participants at the Jamboree.

Personal information may be provided to third parties in the course of management of the Jamboree. In such case, the use of the personal information by any third party will be strictly controlled by means of a contract.

Personal information will be handled in accordance with the relevant laws on the protection of personal information and will be destroyed upon conclusion of the Jamboree.

Any recordings, such as images and videos taken in order to retain a record of the Jamboree, are the property of SAJ.

The recordings of Day Visitors may be used for websites, brochures and other publications in order to promote Scouting and Scouting events.

The recordings will be used in such a manner that it will be difficult to determine the identity of any individual.

By registering personal information, Day Visitors accept the collection and use of personal information, including images and videos. This also applies to Day Visitors and other volunteers

participating in the Jamboree.

8. Others

- The host organization shall refuse entry to the Jamboree site to members or associates of any organized crime syndicate.
- The host organization assumes no responsibility for any accident or theft or loss of personal belongings inside the venue. Each person shall be responsible for their belongings.
- The host organization assumes no responsibility for any injury or damage attributable to a Day Visitor's negligence.
- Day Visitors, including adults responsible for youths, shall be responsible for taking out necessary insurance.
